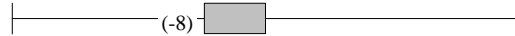

1 Politician/Government Representative

Participates in government administration and policy making (federal, state or local government), and attends meetings of parliament or local council meetings to debate and discuss government issues as the people's elected representative.

Specialisations: Alderman/woman, Government Minister, Governor, Governor-General, Mayor, Member of the Legislative Assembly, Member of the Legislative Council, Premier, Prime Minister, Senator, Territory Administrator.

1 Self Employed/Business Owner

Someone who runs/operates their own business, working either alone or with other people, or who receives profits from a business owned but not run by the individual .

Specialisations: Business Coach, Business Development Coach.

1 Stockbroker/Stockbroking Dealer

Buys and sells stocks and bonds on behalf of clients.

Specialisations: Assets Analyst, Cash Advisor, Commodities Broker, Derivatives Consultant, Equities Dealer, Funds Manager, Futures Manager, Investments Adviser, Investments Analyst, Investments Dealer, Investments Researcher, Securities Dealer, Securitisation Trader, Sharebroker, Stockbroking Manager, Trading Floor Operator (Stock Exchange).

1 Trial Lawyer/Senior Counsel/Barrister

Pleads cases before civil, criminal and industrial courts and tribunals.

Specialisations: Senior Counsel, Senior Counsel - Commercial, Senior Counsel - Corporate, Senior Counsel - Criminal.

Related Titles: Counsel, Senior Counsel, Senior Trial Lawyer, Trial Lawyer.

2 Actuary

Applies mathematical, statistical and economic analyses to a wide range of practical problems in areas of finance such as insurance, superannuation and investment.

Specialisations: Business Analyst, Financial Analyst, Financial Modeller, Insurance Analyst, Investment Analyst, Superannuation Adviser, Superannuation Analyst.

2 Bank/Financial Institution Manager

Manages the general activities of branches of banks, building societies, credit unions or similar financial institutions.

Specialisations: Account Manager, Branch Manager, Building Society Manager, Corporate Finance Director, Credit Union Manager, Financial Analyst, Financial Controller, Fleet Manager, International Banking Manager.

2 Civil Engineer

Plans, designs, organises and oversees the construction and operation of civil engineering projects such as structural (e.g. buildings), transportation (e.g. bridges) or hydraulic engineering systems (e.g. dams).

Specialisations: Construction Engineer, Hydraulics Engineer, Municipal Engineer, Structural Engineer, Traffic Engineer, Transport Engineer (Army), Water Supply Distribution Engineer, Waterways Engineer.

2 Money Market/Securities Dealer

Buys and sells securities (investments such as shares, debentures and bonds) within financial markets, and trades and distributes financial securities on behalf of financial institutions.

Specialisations: Assets Analyst, Cash Advisor, Derivatives Consultant, Derivatives Dealer, Derivatives manager, Equities Dealer, Equities Trader, Fixed Interest Dealer, Foreign Exchange Dealer, Foreign Exchange Manager, Funds Manager, Institutional Dealer, Investments Researcher, Securitisation Trader.
